

## ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES 2020-21

Group	PROGRAMME	MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION *
<b>Group-A</b>	For candidates applying for Diploma Courses in Applied Art, Architectural Assistantship, Art for Drawing Teachers, Automobile Engineering, Cosmetology & Health, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Civil Engineering (Construction Engineering), Civil Engg. (Public Health & Environment Engineering), Computer Engineering Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Digital Electronics, Medical Electronics, Fashion Design, Garment Fabrication Technology, Information Technology Enabled Services & Management (ITES&M), Interior Design, Instrumentation & Control Engineering, Library & Information Science, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical Engg. (Maintenance Engg.) Medical Laboratory Technology, Polymer Technology, Printing Technology, Production Engineering, Textile Design, Tool & Die Making.	<p><b>Passed 10<sup>th</sup> class or any other examination recognized as equivalent to 10<sup>th</sup> class examination, conducted by CBSE / other board with minimum 35% or 3.7 CGPA aggregate. The subjects Science, Mathematics and English are compulsory and the candidate should have passed in each of these three subjects.</b></p> <p><b>Note:</b>  <b>Candidates passing/qualifying class 10<sup>th</sup> under the grading system should have obtained minimum pass grade in the compulsory subjects i.e., Science, Mathematics and English.</b></p>
<b>Group-B</b>	For candidates applying for Diploma in Modern Office Practice (English), Modern Office Practice (Hindi)	<p><b>Passed Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class XII) of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi in any stream of 10+2 or any other examination recognized as equivalent to the Senior Secondary School Certificate with minimum 35% marks in aggregate of the best three subjects including English for MOP (Eng.) and Hindi or Sanskrit for MOP (Hindi). The candidate should have obtained pass marks in the relevant subject i.e. English for MOP (English) and Hindi/Sanskrit for MOP (Hindi).</b></p>
<b>Group-C</b>	For candidates applying for Diploma in Pharmacy	<p><b>Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics OR Biology (Botany and Zoology), i.e., PCM/PCB as compulsory subjects.</b></p>
<b>Group-D</b>	For candidates applying for Lateral Entry to the Diploma Course (For Delhi region candidates only).	<p><b>Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics/Biology i.e., PCM/PCB as compulsory subjects.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p><b>Passed 10+2 Science (with Mathematics as one of the Subjects)</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p><b>10+2 Science with Technical Vocational Subject.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p><b>Passed 10<sup>th</sup>+ITI(2 years)** with appropriate Trade in that order shall be eligible for admission to Second Year Diploma Course(s) of appropriate/analogous Programme (As per point no. 5.2). The ITIs/ITCs must be from Institutes located only in Delhi and affiliated to DGE&amp;T/BTE, Delhi.</b></p>

\* For admission in various diploma courses, the candidate should have qualifications as per minimum eligibility criteria (with or without grace marks).

\*\*ITI pass-outs of trades for which the entry level qualification for admission to ITI is VIII pass or the duration of ITI trade is less than TWO years shall not be considered for lateral entry.

**NOTE: If a candidate has passed his / her qualifying exam from board other than CBSE or State board (India), it will be sole responsibility of the candidate to produce equivalence certificate (CBSE) of qualifying exam (10<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> as applicable) at the time of Admission, failing which, the candidature will not be considered.**
